- Imitates words frequently and spontaneously

- Uses true words within jargon
- Sings independently
- Asks to have some needs met
- Uses a variety of consonant sounds
- Asks, "What's that?"
- Asks for "more"
- Uses single words frequently
- Imitates short phrases
- Uses new words regularly
- Begins to use two-word phrases spontaneously
