## **Early Receptive Language Targets for Children Functioning Below the 12 Month Developmental Level**

- Responds to own name
- Responds with gesture to "Want up?"
- Recognizes family members' names
- Stops when hearing "No" and other inhibitory words
- Waves "Bye bye"
- Gives an object on request with and without cues
- Kisses on request
- Performs familiar activities in daily routines when asked
- Understands names for familiar objects and people
- Participates in social games with gestures
- Begins to identify a few body parts
