- Uses more verb forms
- Completes analogies
- Describes items and differentiates by color, size, shape, and object
- Describes what's going on in sequence picture cards
- Answers a variety of logical questions including: What happened, When, Why, and How questions
- Makes inferences – answers questions about hypothetical events.. "What would you do if..."
- Uses conjunctions to join ideas in more complex sentences (and, but, so, if)
- Expressive vocabulary of more than 1,000 words
